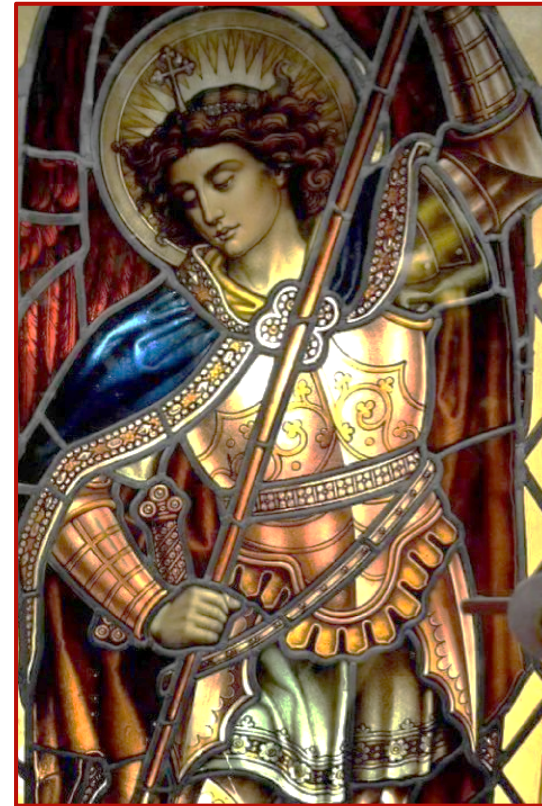

As you probably know, given the continuing situation involving the Corona Virus (COVID-19), most Catholic churches have suspended their Mass schedules. The following adjustments will be necessary to remain in compliance with the Governor's Executive Order regarding public assemblies.

There is a limit of gatherings of more than 50 persons. The Faithful must enter the main entrance at the back, where ushers will be counting the persons entering the church. The side entrance is not to be used (& do not open it from the inside to allow others to enter).

Once the number of persons has reached 50, the additional faithful must wait outside the building. After the congregation departs, the overflow may enter and Father will distribute Communion to them.

Precedence will be given to our regular parishioners.

Confessions will be heard 30 minutes before each Mass and after the last distribution of Holy Communion.

Catechism is canceled until further notice.

There are no coffee & donuts after Mass, and I ask the parishioners to disperse quickly after the services have ended.

Families with small children (those who have not received their first Holy Communion) should keep these children at home if at all possible, as they will have to be counted towards the 50 person limit.

If you are sick, elderly, and/or susceptible to getting sick, do not come to Mass. Please read Fr. Wegner's letter about those who are ill or elderly at [sspqlongisland.com](http://sspqlongisland.com):
